Scholarship recipients will be responsible for all other expenses, including airport transfers, meals not provided during the program and incidentals.

Requisitos:

Eligibility requirements:

\* Be a citizen or permanent resident of an OAS member state. / (Residents must send in a copy of their visa); with the exception of the United States of America since is the host country.

\* To hold a university degree in law, international affairs, engineering, life sciences, or economics;

\* Participants must have responsibilities in public, private, academia on tech transfer, intellectual property, agriculture, life sciences, international trade and innovation, with at least two (2) years of professional experience;

\* Recommendation of Employer-Supporting Institution indicating that the candidate's application is supported by a public, private or academic institution, that the candidate is qualified to undertake a high-level training program in the English language, and their support and commitment for the candidate to return and apply the knowledge acquired during the program;

\* The candidate's application should include a Statement of Study and Development Objectives explaining the reasons for which he/she should be considered as a candidate for the program and for the scholarship;

\* Preference will be given to those candidates from smaller economies
