Grants for foreign students

The Organizer committee of the Summer School on "**Advanced studies on Development "** (**EEAD 2016**) announce the call for grants to support the participation of students from Latin America, the Caribbean and Canada.

Thanks to the support of the *International Development Research Centre* (IDRC-Canadá) it is possible to offer until three grants (CAD \$ 1.500 maximum) to cover the airfare and accommodation costs.

1- Who can apply

Applicants to the IDRC grant must be postgraduate student (Master and Phd Programs).

To apply for the IDRC-grant the students must complete the registration form as "project presentation" and fulfill the requirement previously indicated: a recommendation letter of his/her supervisor and a research project (max 5000 words). Also, a motivation letter and applicants' CV attached are required to be sent to the organizer committee.

The grant application must be sent at the same moment of the registration at the EEAD 2016 though an e-mail to the Organizer Committee (redesarrollo@ei.udelar.edu.uy)

Registration will open in December 1th until December 20th of 2015. Acceptation letter will be sent early in January 2016.

2- Responsibilities of the grant holders and selection criteria.

The students that receive grants must attend at the 100% of the lectures of the EEAD 2016. Also, they must present a working paper with their research project, considering the comments and suggestions received during the EEAD 2016. The working paper must be sent to the Organizer Committee no more than three months after the end of the EEAD 2016. It will be published as Working paper of the University Network on Development Studies.

The selection criteria for grants are:

- Academic quality of the research project
- Motivation letter

- Student qualifications

Also, these evaluation criteria could be applied:

- Diversity of students' country of origin
- PhD students
- Impact of the financial support
